I am a Professor of Sport Psychology in the Faculty of Applied Sciences and also engaged as a Sport Psychologist at the Sport Science Centre of Manav Rachna International University (Delhi, India). Previously I was engaged as a Senior Sport Psychologist at the National Sports Institute of Malaysia. I am honoured to be nominated as a member at large for the Managing Council of the ISSP. Academically, I have been engaged in teaching and research. As a practitioner, I had extended psychological support to Olympic and National level athletes of Malaysia and India. The breadth of my accumulated experiences provides me with a strong basis for my nomination. My research interests are focused on applied issues of performance enhancement. I have a deep understanding of challenges of service delivery in multicultural context. I have secured research funding under Government of India Research Fellowship Program, funding from National Sport Institute of Malaysia and University Grants, resulting in 141 publications (3 book chapters, 12 peer reviewed research articles, 11 general articles, 26 Invited presentations and 89 conference papers / workshops). I have served as a reviewer for journals, as Secretary/Treasurer of Division 12 (Sport Psychology) in IAAP (2006-2010 & 2010-2014) and as an Asian representative of Division 12 (2002-2006). I was the recipient of “Young Scholar Development Award” during ISSP World Congress in 2001 (Greece). My commitment is to constantly strive to gain greater visibility of our field in the larger domain of psychology and a dedication to bring greater recognition within health sciences.
