Biography (250 words)

Franco Noce, Ph.D., is an Associate Professor at the Federal University of Minas Gerais (UFMG), Brazil, where he teaches in the Graduate Program in Sport Sciences and coordinates the Sport Psychology Division at the university's High Performance Training Center. He holds a Ph.D. in Psychobiology from the Federal University of São Paulo, a Master's in Sport Sciences from UFMG, and undergraduate degrees in Physical Education and Psychology. Dr. Noce has more than 30 years of academic and applied experience in sport psychology, combining research with direct involvement in elite sport. He has consulted for several Olympic sports and parasports, and has extensive international experience, notably as a Sport Psychologist at the Brazilian Paralympic Committee at the 2004, 2008, and 2016 Games. More recently, he has worked with leading clubs such as Minas Tênis Clube training teams of sport psychologists. His research focuses on decision-making, stress, motivation, resilience, and mental health in athletes, with applications ranging from high-performance sport to health promotion and social inclusion. Within ISSP, Dr. Noce served as Managing Council Member and Secretary General (2013– 2025), contributing to organizational development, communication strategies, and international collaborations. He also led the Emerging Countries Project Committee, advancing initiatives over the past decade. He is currently Vice President of the Brazilian Association for the Study of Sport and Exercise Psychology (2020–2028). Through this trajectory, Dr. Noce brings academic expertise, applied experience, and international leadership to ISSP, aiming to foster inclusive growth and global collaboration in sport psychology.
